Training Session Overview

Introduction to Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) – (8 hours): Crime Prevention Specialist Sergeant Jonathan McIntosh, Creve Coeur Police Department: Jon will provide an 8 hour block of instruction covering the Introduction to CPTED Principles and Practices. Jon is a recognized expert in this field and has provided several training sessions throughout the state on these topics.

Retail Crime Prevention – (4 hours): Crime Prevention Specialist Sergeant Jonathan McIntosh, Creve Coeur Police Department: Jon will provide a 4 hour block of instruction on general business crime prevention techniques with an emphasis on preventing fraud and thefts from retail establishments.

Addressing Nuisance Properties – What’s Working in Kansas City, Missouri – Ms. Emalea Black, Assistant City Attorney, City of Kansas City, Missouri (2 hours): Every city has them – some more than others...nuisance properties. Learn what avenues have been successful in Kansas City, Missouri between the partnership of the Kansas City Police Department and the City Attorney’s Office of the City of Kansas City, Missouri.

Interpersonal and Community Interaction (2 hours): P.O. Chato Villalobos, KCMO PD: transitioning from occupying force to Community Partner "the Westside CAN Center" story - A conversation about Community Policing best practices - exploring the building of Community relationships for effective problem solving and crime reduction.

Fraud Prevention and the Missouri Attorney General’s Office: (4 hours) – Hon. Eric S. Schmitt, Attorney General of Missouri (invited): The Office of Attorney General of Missouri has far reaching powers and strategies in combating fraud against Missourians. Hear from Attorney General Eric Schmitt what resources the Office of Attorney General has and provides to law enforcement to protect Missourians against Human Trafficking, Identity Theft, Consumer Fraud, Crimes Against Seniors, etc.)
